From the North:

Take Rt. 271 South to Rt. 8 South (Boston Hts., Akron exit). Stay on Rt. 8 until E. Streetsboro St. (Rt. 303) exit (Hudson/Peninsula exit). At end of exit ramp turn left on Rt. 303. Continue on 303 and turn right on Stow Rd.; turn left on Patterson Way.

From the South:

Rt. 8 N to Graham Rd. At end of exit ramp turn right on Graham Rd. Take Graham Rd. to Darrow Rd. (Rt. 91) and turn left. Take Darrow Rd. to Stow Rd. and turn right. Go 3.5 miles to Patterson Way and turn right.

From the East or West:

Take I-480 to Darrow Rd (Rt. 91 South), left on E Streetsboro St. (Rt. 303), right on Stow Road, Left on Patterson Way.
